
Headquarters of Fortune 100 Company Cooling Towers and Chillers



Background

In April of 2016, a Fortune 100 LEED Gold certified headquarters in Houston, Texas, contracted with HydroTech Solutions to initiate Total Water Management (TWM) as a service program for their cooling towers and chillers.


The TWM program includes:

- *Hydro*FLOW electronic water conditioners, which provide eco-friendly scale, bacteria and corrosion contro.
- IoT (Internet of Things) sensors & meters, which continuously monitor flow rates, temperatures and water quality.
- Cloud based platform that securely analyzes and displays data.
- Monthly site visits to inspect equipment, water quality and operations.



Key Success Factors

- Reduction of scale and biofouling accumulation in the cooling towers and chillers.
- At least 50% conservation of blow-down water.
- Chemical reduction and optimization.
- Increased life-cycle of equipment, fill material and piping.
- Reduction in energy costs.
- Reduction in
 maintenance costs.
